

Elective Information

Professional MBA 2-Year Class of Fall 2012 (P2MBAF12)

The Professional MBA 2-Year Program curriculum is lock-step in nature, meaning all students take the same classes each term. The one exception is that all students will be required to choose one 2-credit elective.

The electives will be taught during one-week residences in Gainesville, during the Fall and Spring semesters. The known dates for the electives are listed below. Each P2MBAF12 student must plan to come to Gainesville during one of the residences to take an elective course some time before completing the program.

Students wishing to take additional electives may do so, for an additional charge, on a space-available basis.

The dates for the electives taught during the P2MBAF12 program are as follows:

Fall 2010	October 18-22, 2010
Spring 2011	March 7-11, 2011
Fall 2011	October 17-21, 2011
Spring 2012	March 5-9, 2012
Fall 2012	TBA

* While we are confident these dates will not change, they are determined indirectly by the University of Florida's academic calendar. There is a slight possibility they may change. Any changes will be communicated to all MBA students immediately.

Note that some electives may require prerequisites. Therefore, you may need to wait until having completed certain P2MBA courses before taking certain electives.

Specific elective course titles, descriptions and prerequisites will be available at a later date, as will complete registration instructions.
