

Additional Information for Applicants with International Credentials:

Required Documentation:

Copies of the following items may be accepted for the application process only. Upon an offer of Admission, official transcripts, degrees, and certified translations must be presented at or before the orientation session for the program that you are admitted to.

Transcripts/Degrees

All applicants must submit official copies in the native language of each transcript, mark sheet and diploma/degree certificate from each university or college a degree was earned from, along with **certified** English translations. * *A notarized translation is not considered official nor is a translation by the applicant*

Credential evaluation reports prepared by private agencies cannot be submitted in place of transcripts; the university requires official academic credentials.

If your institution does not provide certified translations of your transcripts and degree statements the university will accept translations from a certified private translator or the following translation service:

TOEFL(Test of English as a Foreign Language)

All non-US applicants must submit the TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) scores as part of the application process, unless they are citizens of a country where English is an official language, have spent at least one academic year as a full-time student at a college or university in a country where English is an official language, earned a prior bachelor's degree, master's degree or doctoral degree at an accredited university in the United States.
